God Renews Our Strength! Our Unshakable God! Pt.5 Isaiah 40:31

Isaiah 40:28, Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. **29** He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. **30** Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; **31** but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Deuteronomy 31:11, when all Israel comes to appear before the LORD your God at the place he will choose, you shall read this law before them in their hearing. **12** Assemble the people—men, women and children, and the foreigners residing in your towns—so they can listen and learn to fear the LORD your God and follow carefully all the words of this law.

Job 39:27, Does the eagle soar at your command and build its nest on high? **28** It dwells on a cliff and stays there at night; a rocky crag is its stronghold. **29** From there it looks for food; its eyes detect it from afar.

When God Renews Our Strength:

1. Hope Is <u>RESTORED</u>

<u>Isaiah 40:31</u>, but those who hope in the LORD...

Hebrews 6:19, We have this <u>hope</u> as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure.

Romans 15:13, May the God of <u>hope</u> fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him...

Romans 5:1, Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. 3 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; 4 perseverance, character; and character, hope. 5 And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

2. God Refills What the World DEPLETES

Isaiah 40:31, ... will renew their strength.

<u>Lamentations 3:22</u>, Because of the LORD'S great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. **23** They are <u>new</u> every morning; great is your faithfulness.

<u>Psalm 27:14</u>, Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.

3. We Can Soar Above the STORMS

<u>Isaiah 40:31</u>, ... They will soar on wings like eagles...

Colossians 3:1, Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Exodus 19:4, You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.

Psalm 23:4, Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me...

4. We Have Grace to Go the **DISTANCE**

<u>Isaiah 40:31,</u> ... they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

1 Corinthians 9:21, To those not having the law I became like one not having the law (though I am not free from God's law but am under Christ's law), so as to win those not having the law. 22 To the weak I became weak, to win the weak. I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. 23 I do all this for the sake of the gospel, that I may share in its blessings. 24 Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize?

Psalm 91:1, Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. **2** I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust." **3** Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. **4** He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.
