Make Room In Your Relationships! Make Room, Pt. 3 Mark 12:30-31, John 13:34-35, 2 Corinthians 5:17-18 August 27, 2023

Mark 12:30, Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' 31 The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."

<u>John 13:34</u>, "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. <u>35</u> By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

<u>1 Corinthians 13:4</u>, Love <u>is</u> patient, love <u>is</u> kind. It does <u>not</u> envy, it does <u>not</u> boast, it is <u>not</u> proud. **5** It does <u>not</u> dishonor others, it is <u>not</u> self-seeking, it is <u>not</u> easily angered, it keeps <u>no</u> record of wrongs. **6** Love does <u>not</u> delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. **7** It <u>always</u> protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. **8** Love never fails.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>, Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the <u>new creation</u> has come: The old has gone, the new is here! **18** All this is from God, who <u>reconciled</u> us to himself through Christ and gave us the <u>ministry of reconciliation</u>:

Four Thoughts on Relational Reconciliation:

1. Remember That Person Is Deeply Loved <u>BY GOD</u>

Romans 5:8, But God demonstrates his own love for <u>us</u> in this: While <u>we</u> were still sinners, Christ died for <u>us</u>.

2. Ask Yourself: What Role Did I Play in the PROBLEM?

<u>Psalm 139:23</u>, Search <u>me</u>, God, and know <u>my</u> heart; test <u>me</u> and know <u>my</u> anxious thoughts. **24** See if there is any offensive way in <u>me</u>, and lead <u>me</u> in the way everlasting.

3. Move Into the Conversation With the Purpose of Reconciliation not Placing the <u>BLAME</u>

<u>James 5:16</u>, Therefore <u>confess your sins</u> to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.

<u>Ephesians 4:32</u>, Be kind and compassionate to <u>one</u> another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ <u>God</u> forgave you.

4. Bear With One Another as You Begin to **BOUNCE** BACK

Ephesians 4:2, Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

<u>Colossians 3:13</u>, <u>Bear</u> with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
