Genesis 1:1, In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

John 1:3, Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. **4** In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

Three Things the Bible Says About Jesus Christ:

1. The Humanity of Christ

• Christ was Fully Human

John 1:4, In him was life ... **14** The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

• Christ Was Born Into This World

Matthew 1:18, This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit.

• Christ Was Held to the Same Standards as We Are

<u>Galatians 4:4,</u> But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law,

• Christ Was Tempted as We Are

Hebrews 4:15, For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.

• Christ Felt Pain

Luke 19:41, As he approached Jerusalem and saw the city, he wept over it

2. The Deity of Christ

John 1:1, In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Colossians 2:9, For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, **10** and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority.

• Christ Was Addressed as King

Matthew 2:1, After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem **2** and asked, "Where is the one who has been **born king of the Jews**? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."

John 1:49, Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel."

• While on Earth, in Human Flesh, Christ Was Worshipped

Matthew 2:11, On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

<u>Matthew 14:32</u>, And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. **33** Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

• Jesus Performed Miracles

3. The Salvation of Christ

John 1:4, In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

Colossians 2:13, When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, **14** having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.

John 14:6, Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

Romans 3:23, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 10:9, If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.
