

**Making Room for God in Your Sacrifice!**

Hebrews 13:15-16, Joshua, 2 Chronicles 24  
October 15, 2023

**Hebrews 13:15**, Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name. **16** And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

**How to Make a Sacrifice That Pleases God:**

**1. Have a God-Sized VISION**

**Exodus 3:8**, So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey — the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites

**2. Don't Ever Let Your Age Limit Your FAITH**

**Joshua 14:10**, ... So here I am today, eighty-five years old! **11** I am still as strong today as the day Moses sent me out; I'm just as vigorous to go out to battle now as I was then. **12** Now give me this hill country that the LORD promised me that day.

**3. Believe God Will Do Something GREAT**

**Joshua 1:10**, So Joshua ordered the officers of the people: **11** "Go through the camp and tell the people, 'Get your provisions ready. Three days from now you will cross the Jordan here to go in and take possession of the land the LORD your God is giving you for your own.'"

**4. Put Your Faith Into ACTION**

**Joshua 3:14**, So when the people broke camp to cross the Jordan, the priests carrying the ark of the covenant went ahead of them. **15** Now the Jordan is at flood stage all during harvest. Yet as soon as the priests who carried the ark reached the Jordan and their feet touched the water's edge, **16** the water from upstream stopped flowing..

**5. Go With God's PEOPLE**

**Joshua 3:17**, The priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD stopped in the middle of the Jordan and stood on dry ground, while all Israel passed by until the whole nation had completed the crossing on dry ground.

**2 Chronicles 24:10**, All the officials and all the people brought their contributions gladly, dropping them into the chest until it was full. **11** Whenever the chest was brought in by the Levites to the king's officials and they saw that there was a large amount of money, the royal secretary and the officer of the chief priest would come and empty the chest and carry it back to its place. They did this regularly and collected a great amount of money. **12** The king and
