A Skeptic's Encounter With Jesus! Encounter: Jesus Through the Book of John, Pt. 3 John 3 March 19, 2023

John 2:23, Now while he was in Jerusalem at the Passover Festival, many people saw the <u>signs</u> he was performing and <u>believed in his name</u>.

How Skeptics Come to Christ:

1. They Come at Unexpected <u>TIMES</u>

John 3:1, Now there was a Pharisee, a man named Nicodemus who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. 2 <u>He came to Jesus at night</u>...

2. They Have a Lot of <u>QUESTIONS</u>

John 3:2, Nicodemus said, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God. <u>For no</u> <u>one could perform the signs</u> you are doing <u>if God</u> <u>were not with him</u>." 3 Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are <u>born again</u>."

Question:

John 3:4, "How can someone be born when they are old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother's womb to be born!"

Jesus' Answer:

John 3:5, Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. 6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.

Most Important Question:

John 3:9, "How can this be?" Nicodemus asked.

Jesus' Answer:

John 3:10, "You are Israel's teacher," said Jesus, "and do you not understand these things? ... 13 No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven—the <u>Son of</u> <u>Man</u>. 14 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so <u>the Son of Man must be lifted</u> <u>up</u>, 15 <u>that everyone who believes may have</u> <u>eternal life in him</u>."

3. They Need God's LOVE

John 3:16, For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that <u>whoever</u> <u>believes in him shall not perish but have eternal</u> <u>life</u>. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, <u>but to save the world</u> <u>through him</u>.

4. They Might Still Reject <u>JESUS</u>

John 3:18, Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. **19** <u>This is the verdict</u>: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

What About Nicodemus?

John 19:39, He (Joseph of Arimathea) was accompanied by <u>Nicodemus</u>, the man who earlier had visited Jesus at night. <u>Nicodemus</u> brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about seventy-five pounds. 40 Taking Jesus' body, <u>the two of them</u> <u>wrapped</u> it, with the spices, in strips of linen.

John 3:36, Whoever believes in the Son has eternal <u>life</u>, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them.
